ENTRIES: No entry will be accepted unless it is made via the respective National Association.

Individual Event Category Entries on behalf of an MNF that has not entered either of the respective Team events, must be made by **Monday**, **2**nd **June 2025 (23:59hrs GMT)**. No late entries will be accepted.

The Entry Fee of \$185 USD per person must be paid in advance alongside any hotel bookings made. This fee is not payable by the four individual squad players competing in either of the respective Team events, as it is included in the team entry fee.

Entries must be paid in advance by bank transfer.

The entry fee is not refundable in the case of withdrawal after the entry deadline.

The Organisers will provide transport between the airport and the hotel on arrival and departure for all players. Shuttle transport between hotel and venue will be provided from 20th July for players. Any accompanying officials, individuals, supporters and family members can arrange transfers and shuttle transport by purchasing a travel pass through bank transfer (net of charges).

ANTI-DOPING:

- 1. The Host Nation will implement compulsory anti-doping tests for any players participating in the World Championship on behalf of the WSF.
- 2. There shall be no doping before or during play in any competition under WSF Rules.
- 3. Any player refusing to undergo doping control and any player found guilty of a doping infraction will be dealt with by the WSF, which shall take disciplinary action in accordance with its constitution/regulations.

CHAMPIONSHIP OFFICE:

Championship Office will be situated at the venue and will be open from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM from 20th July 2025.

CLOTHING AT FUNCTIONS:

To ensure a professional squash image all Individuals and any accompanying officials **must** wear the following clothing at each of the functions where attendance is mandatory:

Opening Ceremony: National Team Tracksuit for players (for march-in) Closing Dinner: Formal Team Clothing and or Jackets (not team tracksuit)

CLOTHING REG - TV /STREAMING:

In order for squash to be well presented on television and when streamed it is essential that the two players wear different colours and that if they change shirts during matches they keep to the colour they had on before. So two colours must be brought to championships. Here is the full World Championship Regulation L4.

For any match covered by television, players' clothing shall conform to the advertising regulations published and generally applied by the appropriate television authority of the Host Country; and for all matches (excepting Masters) both players must wear distinctly different coloured clothing – the colour must not change during a match. (Where colours are similar, the lower placed individual/team on the draw sheet must change colour). Failure to do so will result in an automatic UK£100 fine per match levied by the Technical Delegate and invoiced by the WSF office; payable by the nation of the player concerned.

CLOTHING:

In all WSF World Individual and Team Championships - with the sole exception of World Masters, shirts or tops must carry a national identification title as defined below (World Championship Regulation L6).







- a) May carry the manufacturer's normal trademark, symbol or name on one breast the display to be contained within an area not exceeding 20 square centimetres in total and 10 centimetres in any one dimension.
- b) May carry identification, in areas clearly separated from each other, on the opposite breast to the manufacturer's symbol and/or on each arm and/or on the back, as follows:
- On the centre of the front one sponsors display to be contained within an area not exceeding 80 square centimetres in total and 20 centimetres in any one dimension; and
- **ii)** On sleeves one sponsors display and one national identification badge each contained within an area not exceeding 40 square centimetres in total and 10 centimetres in any one dimension.
- c) In all WSF World Individual and Team Championships with the sole exception of World Masters, shirts or tops <u>must</u> carry a national identification title as defined below. They <u>may</u> also include a player name on them.
- National Identification
 A national identification title, the whole to be contained within an area at least 200 square centimetres and not exceeding 300 square centimetres on the back of the
- b) The player's name may also be displayed within an additional area not exceeding 150 square centimetres.
- c) Lettering must be in one colour that strongly contrasts with the shirt colour.

Shorts and skirts/dresses shall be of design normally approved and used for squash.

Examples of actual size dimensions may be found at Appendix L in the WSF Championship Regulations.

ELIGIBILITY:

Age requirements are defined as Under-19 years of age as at the final scheduled day of the Championship event i.e. born on or after 27th July 2005 (Individual Championship) and on or after 2nd August 2005 (Men's & Women's World Junior Team Championship).

All players must be eligible to represent a Full Member Nation of the WSF and have an activated SPIN Registration. All designated officials e.g. player / team managers and coaches must also have an activated SPIN Registration (but coaches are not required to have a WSF Coach qualification).

All players must have passed the WSO Player Certificate - Tournament Level, in order to participate, full details of which can be found here: WSO Player Certificate - Tournament Level.

ENTRY NUMBER:

WSF World Championship Regulations X4 & X5 extract:

Men's and Women's (Regulations X4 & X5):

There will be a maximum of 6 players from an MNF that has entered either of the respective Team events and a maximum of 2 players from an MNF that has not entered either of the respective Team events.

Individual entries close on Monday, 2nd June 2025 @ 23:59GMT - No late entries will be accepted.

EVENTS:

The championships shall be played under the current WSF Rules of the Game and the WSF World Championship Regulations.

Individual events will play out plates on a knockout basis, except that in both events there will not be a 3 / 4 playoff.







** subject however to the total number of player registrations

Plate events will be held as follows to offer all players a minimum of three matches whenever possible:

Plate: For First Round losers in the Main Draw
 Classic Plate: For Second Round losers in the Main Draw

Consolation Plate: For First Round losers in the Plate

All players are automatically entered in the different plates unless they advise the Championship Director that they do not want to be included immediately after losing their matches. Any player who does not withdraw within **2 hours** of losing and fails to arrive to participate in the Plate, excepting for medical reasons, will face possible disciplinary action.

Disclaimer: Should the Individual Championship draw size be too large for the scheduled days then the lowest positions will not be played out to final position.

EYEWEAR: All players are required to wear WSF certified protective eyewear throughout the

Championship in accordance with the following World Championship Regulation:

MNFs through their Team Managers must ensure that all their players (under 19 years of age) wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play. It is the responsibility of the individual player to ensure that the quality of the product worn is satisfactory for the purpose. The list of WSF Certified Eyewear allowable at the time of participation can

be viewed on the WSF website.

FLAG/ANTHEM: Each competing nation is required to bring a standard sized national flag for use during

the Championship.

FUNCTIONS: There will be functions held during the Championship. Full details will be supplied in the

Championship Handbook.

INSURANCE: All players, officials and teams must cover their own personal insurance. Competitors

enter and play in the Championship at their own risk. Neither the WSF, the Host Nation, the Organisers nor the host venues accept any responsibility for injury nor financial loss

arising from participation in the Championship.

OFFICIAL BALL: The Dunlop Pro Championship Ball will be used for all matches.

PRACTICE COURTS: Courts for practice (free of charge) are available from 19th July 2025. The schedule for

the practice times will be available at the Championship Offices.

REGISTRATION: Registrations will take place at the Championship hotels. On arrival at the hotels, check

in at the Championship / Registration Office where players will get their registration and

player packs.

SQUAD

SUBMISSION: The deadline for squad submissions for both the Men's and Women's World Junior Team

events will be 2nd June 2025 (23:59 GMT).

TICKETS: Each member of a squad at a Team Championship shall be entitled to a seat on the front

row behind the back wall for each session on the court on which their team is playing (maximum six). Each squad member and team official (max six persons) shall be entitled to a maximum of two complimentary seats for guests for the court on which its team is

playing.







Each player at an Individual Championship shall be entitled to the above for their country and guests but, where there is no following Team Championship that they are competing in, the maximum will be two seats on the front row behind the back wall for each session on the court that they are participating in.

TRANSPORT: The Organisers will provide transport between the airport and the hotel on arrival and

departure for all players. Shuttle transport between hotel and venue will be provided from 20th July for all players. Any accompanying officials, individuals, supporters and family members can arrange transfers and shuttle transport by purchasing a travel pass

through the Egyptian Squash Federation.

A regular shuttle service (hotel/venue/hotel) will be provided from **20th July 2025**.

TROPHIES: The WSF Trophies and medals will be awarded in the Championship events. No prize

money is awarded in any WSF Junior event.
